Training

All adults working as cashiers must complete the following TABC Seller/Server Training Course on line. <http://www.statefoodsafety.com/Cps?productType=Alcohol+Server> The cost is \$14.50, and the approximate course length is 2 hours. Uniforms

Here is an excerpt from the uniform policy:

- SHIRTS: Provided at the start of each shift
 - Restaurant storefront will have a specific uniform shirt with logo.
 - Premiums Level will wear designated shirts with logo.
- Hats/Hair: (Hats will be provided by the booster club for all volunteers for uniformity.)
 - **MUST** wear a hat or hair net
 - Absolutely NOT to be worn backwards, sideways, upside down or around the neck
 - Hair longer than shoulder length **MUST** be in a braid or bun
 - All hair must be pulled away from the face and under the hat
- Dell Diamond - Khaki pants, mid-thigh length shorts or capri's
- Dell Diamond – comfortable shoes
 - Must be closed around the entire foot
 - NO open toed shoes, sandals or Crocs
- NO excessive jewelry and NO facial piercings; no visible tattoos
- ABSOLUTELY NO REFERENCES TO OTHER TEAMS

Shift start time is 4:30 pm for most evening games. However, only a few need to be there early to help set up. Everyone else must be there by 5:30. Parking is free. The gate opens at 5:30 for family members that are not volunteering that evening.
